Call for Notary Assistance at the Voting Polls

The LNA is assisting with finding notaries and lawyers who would like to stand in at the polls for COVID-19 affected commissioners. Currently, we are looking to recruit approximately 300 polling commissioners state-wide with the biggest need reported so far coming from Jefferson Parish as 70% of their commissioners are not returning due to COVID-19. Full PPE including masks, face shields and protective clothing will be provided and all polling sites will have the National Guard posted to help manage the lines to ensure social distancing.

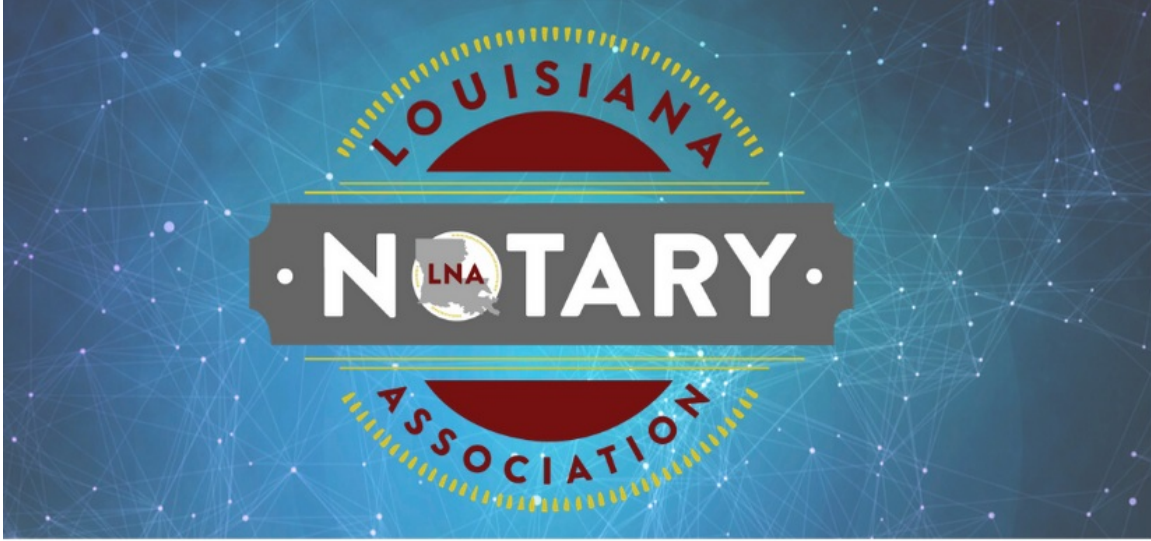

Due to the governor's stay-at-home order and for the safety of notaries across the state and their families, we are suspending all in-person Shop Talks for the month of July.

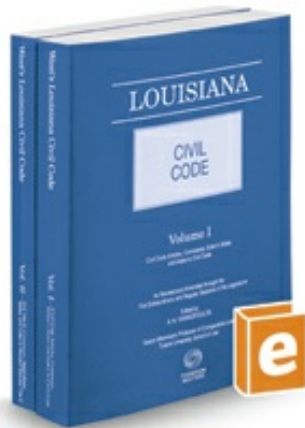

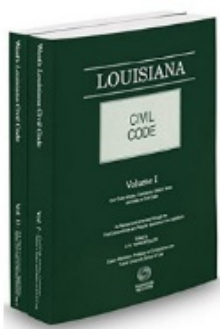
